	Film – Selma 2014. Historical drama based on the 1965 march from Selma to Montgomery lead by Dr. Martin Luther King Jnr.

	Novel – ‘Roll of Thunder, Hear my Cry.’ By Mildred Taylor . 1976. Set in Mississippi at the height of the American Depression, this is the story of a family's struggle to maintain their integrity, pride and independence against the forces of a cruelly racist society.		
	Novel – ‘I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings.’ By Maya Angelou . 1969. The first of seven autobiographies revealing Maya Angelou’s life as a young black girl growing up in racist America.		
	Poem – ‘ To a Mouse ’ by Robert Burns. This poem inspired the title of John Steinbeck’s novel Of Mice and Men with its line, ‘The best laid schemes o’ Mice an’ Men.’		
	Biographies - Rosa Parks, Dr. Martin Luther King Jnr. Non-Fiction – The Great Depression, The American Dream, The Civil Rights Movement.
